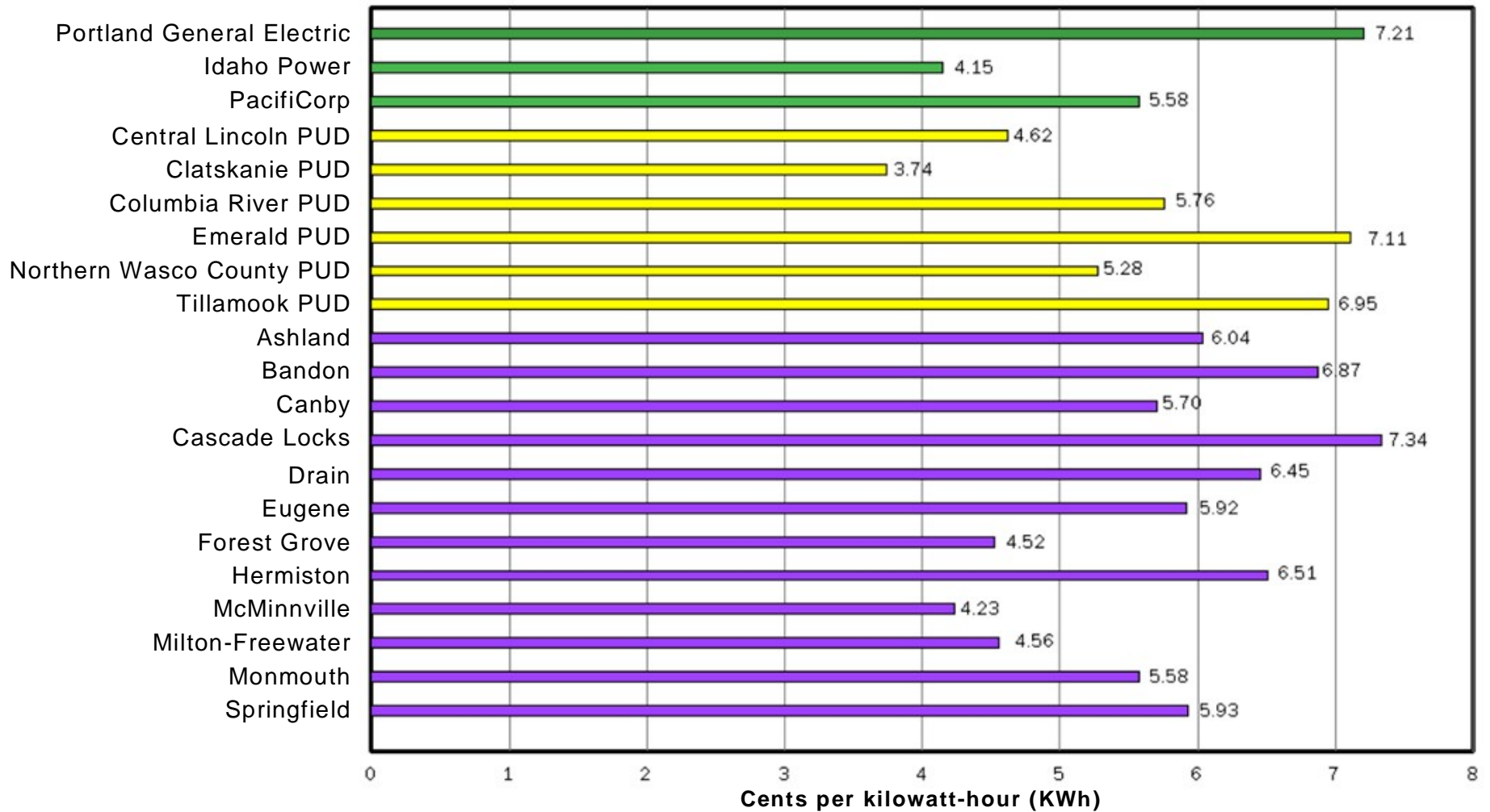


PGE's Electric Rates vs. Publicly-Owned Utilities

Of the five People's Utility Districts and twelve Municipal-Owned utilities in Oregon, all but Cascade Locks (561 customers) have lower rates than PGE. The cost of publicly-owned power averaged 5.73 cents per kilowatt-hour, 21 percent less than Portland General Electric.
